TO: Student Nurses registered with a University offering a Degree in Nursing Science.

All the forms that we will require from you should accompany your application – see below. Your lecturers and faculty staff will then choose the top 4 most deserving exceptional student nurses from your faculty, for these awards. Unfortunately, funds will only be awarded to 2nd, 3rd and 4th year students. We are hesitant to fund students who may choose to follow another career later.

THE FOLLOWING STUDENTS WILL BE CONSIDERED:

- South African citizens will take priority, but foreign students will be considered
- Students registered for a Bachelor in Nursing Science Degree at a South African University
- From a previously disadvantaged community
- Students not meeting the above criteria should still apply.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED OF EACH APPLICANT: (All documents must be submitted together for each student)

- Full name, address, name of the university, year group and student registration number
- A certified copy of the Identity document
- Contact details of student applicant: cell number and personal email address
- Most recent academic transcript
- Student account/financial record on a University letterhead.
- Proof that practical nursing hours are up to date
- A character reference
- A reference from clinical practice educator
- A recent, good quality photograph
- Personal motivation letter completed by student: see questions below.

QUESTIONS TO BE ANSWERED AND SUBMITTED BY THE STUDENT:

- Why did you choose a career in nursing?
- What do you enjoy most about nursing?
- What do you find the most challenging about nursing?
- What qualities are essential in an exceptional nurse?
- Do you have a personal philosophy or faith conviction?
- How does that influence the way you live?
- How do you hope to influence your colleagues to be exceptional nurses?

Please make sure that ALL the student's documents are submitted together, with that student's name. A missing document will jeopardise that student's overall score. We are really looking forward to receiving your exceptional student nurse nominations, by the end of September, this year.
